



## Reindeer Hide Care Instructions

The reindeer hide has a beautiful thick pile and as such you can expect a little shedding once you have it in-situ. We suggest that you follow the advice below and that way your reindeer hide will last for many years and still look as good as the day you bought it!

### **Where can you use your hide?**

You can use your reindeer hide both indoors and outside.

#### **Indoors:**

- /// Try not to let pets get too attached to it ... especially cats which have a tendency to rake out the hair;
- /// Don't position in front of a fireplace (at least for long periods of time) as extreme heat can cause shedding.

#### **Outdoors:**

- /// As long as the hide is thoroughly dried out after being outside in the wet, it shouldn't get damaged.

### **Care Advice:**

- 1.** Once you have your new hide, we recommend that you give it a good shake at least a couple of times a week, initially, as you'll find that it will probably shed a significant amount of hair. (With such a thick pile this shouldn't alter the look or feel of the hide in any way.)
- 2.** After a few weeks the shedding should subside but we do suggest that you keep shaking it out from time to time.
- 3.** Finally, if possible, leave your hide outside for a day or so every few weeks. This will help preserve the hide and stop further shedding.
